To All Our Valentines

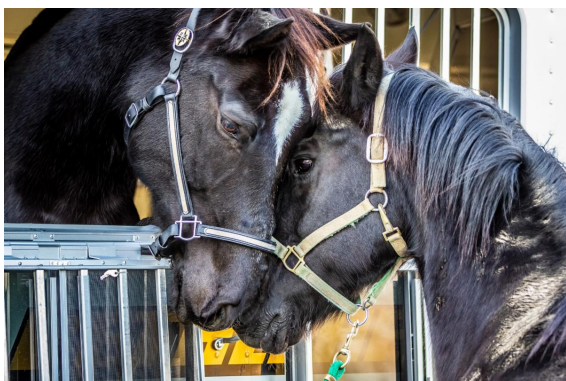
